



### **BERNINA Club for Beginners**

**Sewing machine with all attachments including embroidery module and hoops.**

**Fabric:** Muslin: 4 - 12 x 10 inch muslin or plain fabric (Not patterned) for practicing sewing techniques

1- 15 x 20 muslin or plain fabric (not patterned) for practicing embroidery techniques.

**Stabilizer:** Same sizes as the fabric pieces listed above - tear away or cut away. Those samples you may have received with your machine or at a Sulky class will work well here for the 12 x 10 samples.

1 – 15 x 20 tear away or cut away

**Thread:** 1 - cotton thread for sewing that

1 – bobbin thread

**Needles:** 80/12 and 90/14 – recommend sharps or topstitch Sewing Machine, Embroidery Hoops, Presser feet and Bobbins - you will need the following presser feet...and bring what came with your machine.

#1C or #1D or #20

#97 D (1/4 inch foot) or #8 (Jean's foot)

#10D

#26

**Project for future classes will be “Running with Scissors” (pattern required) carrying case.**

Supplies listed on pattern – with an additional 0.3 m of coordinating fabric that will show off an embroidery design – something that is monotone/marbled
