



Design Your Own Bargello Quilt

This is a fun class for the quilter looking for a bit more bargello challenge. Anyone can follow a pattern, right? But to design your own bargello pattern requires a bit more creativity and thought! One advantage is you will have a unique, one-of-a-kind quilt that will amazing everyone who sees it.

As with all bargello quilts, the design is produced by the positioning of many different tones of fabric in one or two colour themes. I suggest at least 0.7m of 12 to 20 fabrics.

You will need to bring to class:

1. "Bargello Quilts in Motion" by Ruth Ann Berry
2. Large cutting mat
3. Rotary cutter with a sharp blade
4. 6" x 24" ruler
5. Your selected fabrics (at least 1.7m of 12-20 fabrics)
6. Grid paper, pencil and ruler
7. Sewing machine in good working order
8. Scissors, thread, bobbins, pins and seam ripper

I'm sure you will have fun in this class and I look forward to seeing you there.
