



Quilt Making Basics

In this class you will learn basic piecing techniques as you construct blocks using squares and triangles to make a lap-sized quilt top.

Our first class will be an orientation class. We will talk about color theory and pattern, and translate this to fabric selection. We will discuss fabric preparation, essential supplies, and optional “wish-list” items. We will explore fabric options and select fabrics during the first class.

These supplies will be required for the first class:

- 3 ring binder for all class notes
- Pencil/pen for taking notes

You will not need your sewing machine for the first class.

For week two you will need the following items:

- Sewing Machine in good working condition. Please bring your manual if you have it.
- Please ensure that you bring all of your presser feet, attachments, foot controller, and cord.

All other supplies including fabric and notions will be discussed in the first class, and a supply list will be handed out at that time.
