**A Trip Around the World Quilt**  
**Saturdays: April 11<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup> 9:30 – 12:30**

In this class we will focus on the method of strip-piecing to make a bold and colourful (or gentle and peaceful) lap-sized quilt (53" X 63"). Strip-piecing makes fast work of small squares to create an eye-catching quilt filled with movement.

Skill Level: Confident Beginner. To best enjoy this class, you must be familiar with your sewing machine and be comfortable both using a rotary cutter and sewing a ¼ inch seam.

**Supply List**

- Pattern Required: *Around the World* by Busy Hands Quilts

**Basic Sewing Supplies**

- Sewing machine in good working order (foot pedal, cord, manual, accessories, bobbins, and ¼" foot.
- New sewing machine needle – Microtex 80/12
- Thread to match your fabrics
- Fine, sharp pins such as Clover Silk Pins
- Rotary cutter, 24" acrylic ruler, and self-healing mat
- Fabric marking pencil/chalk
- Seam ripper
- Awl or stiletto
- Thread snips

**Fabric Requirements**

- Accent fabric (your darkest fabric): 0.7 m
- 10 other fabrics: 0.4 m each
- Binding fabric (can be the same as your accent fabric): 0.5 m
