



Linnea's Sewing Club – April – Weekend Rag Quilt – 1 Wednesday – April 29th – 10 am to 3:30 pm – South

The Weekend Rag Quilt is super-cute, comfy and would be perfect for a Mother's Day gift, a birthday gift or a special surprise for a child in your life. And it's so quick and easy that you can make it in a weekend!

Great for beginners, or anyone looking for a quick finish with a big impact. Defying all the laws of sewing, this comfy quilt is made with the seams exposed which are then "ragged" up to create this fabulous, cozy effect.

This quilt is pure fun and a perfect way to showcase soft flannel fabric prints. It uses the Quilt-As-You-Go method and has no binding, so once your patchwork pieces are assembled, you're done! We will be making the throw size: 53" x 68" (134.6cm x 172.7cm)"

All cutting of fabrics must be done at home prior to class to allow sufficient time to sew in class. Cutting instructions are in pattern.

Note – do NOT prewash fabrics before cutting or assembling quilt

Supplies:

- o Pattern Required: The Weekend Rag Quilt by Studio M Squared
- o For cutting fabrics at home: rotary cutter, cutting mat, and ruler

Supplies required in class:

- o Sewing machine in good working order (foot pedal, cord, manual, accessories, bobbins and walking foot required. If you do not have a walking foot, please inquire at Johnson's if we carry one for your machine.)
- o Sewing notions (pins/clips, fabric scissors, marking chalk or air erasable pen, seam ripper, thread snips, we will discuss different kinds of rag quilt snips in class – you do not need them for the start of class)
- o One set small Post-it notes

Materials:

Note – do NOT prewash fabrics before cutting or assembling quilt

- o 0.7 m each of five different 100% cotton flannel fabrics (42" wide fabric). If using narrower fabric, you will need extra in order to cut 13 - 8" squares of each fabric
- o 1.15 m 90" wide cotton quilt batting
- o 2.75 m 100% cotton flannel fabric for backing (42" wide fabric). If using narrower fabric, you will need extra in order to cut 65 - 8" squares
- o Coordinating polyester thread or topstitching weight cotton thread and suitable machine needles (we can discuss in class if you have any questions)
