



WONDERGARDEN – Intermediate Foundation Paper Piecing

SUPPLY LIST

Sewing machine in good working order, feet, cord and manual

¼" foot

Open toe foot

75/11 Microtex needle

Neutral thread

Fabric washable glue

Sharpie fine pen

24" self healing mat, 24" acrylic ruler

Rotary cutter

12" Add a quarter ruler

Either a long post card of something that has a straight edge and can withstand pulling against it.

Magic Tape

Flat head pins or binding clips

White freezer paper

Any pattern in the wonder garden series by Tamara Kate. This pattern is printed on legal size paper. I took mine to staples and got them to photocopy. The drawback is that it is hard to see where the shape ends. If you take it to Staples, make sure they copy it one sided. You can trace it on freezer paper, just put the corner marks on and use your ruler and cutter to cut it out.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

This makes a lap sized quilt.

2m background fabric

0.5m fabric for glove

0.5m fabric for binding

Fat quarters of all other fabric

PRE-COURSE WORK

Trace all pattern pieces onto the foundation paper which can be taped together. The large pieces with no paper piecing pieces on it, can be traced onto the white freezer paper. All numbers and symbols are added to each piece. Cut out leaving ¼" all around.
