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## **FABULOUS FINISHINGS.**

In this class you will learn to attach a traditional binding with a lumpless join. On the second square, one side you will attach a bias binding and the other, a binding used for placemats. You will be shown the following bindings: prairie point, piping, cottage finish, reverse cottage finish and ruffled. We will also cover a hanging sleeve for wall hangers.

### **GENERAL SUPPLY LIST:**

Sewing machine in good working order with walking foot attached.  
A new 80/12 sewing machine needle  
Neutral thread  
Pins  
Rotary cutter, acrylic ruler and self healing board  
Pencil or chalk to mark fabric  
Seam ripper  
Scissors

### **FABRIC SUPPLY LIST:**

2 – 12 ½” layered squares. This means they both have a backing, batting and front. Quilt a few lines to hold them together. We will add the binding to these.  
12 ½” square of fabric to make bias binding  
2 – 2 ½” strips of fabric  
1 – 1 1/8” strip of fabric
